A BRIEF REVIEW OF SOME DEVELOPMENTS AND ACTIVITIES DURING JANUARY 2020

In January 2020, two churches began the process of establishing a common law or Bible trust relationship with money and property. The ministry also counseled with three other pastors regarding getting a trust bank account and the options of using either the trustee's social security number or an EIN for the account. A PowerPoint on the EIN is available for any church the ministry aids in organization as a New Testament church.

Below is just some of the ministry activities. In January 2020, I worked with pastors, churches, and other believers to include the following:

1. December 31, 2019 through January 6, 2020: Spent some time in phone calls with a gentleman trying to explain what the ministry does and why it cannot, at this point, help him. He stated, in one of his e-mails: "Gods Kingdom is within us I don't believe that it's necessarily an outward kingdom but the kingdom is within us. I believe that Christ is the king, we are the disciples and the kingdom is the church. When He and we pray that thy kingdom come, we're just establishing that growing more and moving forward on Earth. He prayed that it would come before some if those standing there would see death, it would come during the time of the disciples and I 100% believe that it came and it will continue to grow. Sure, there is more, but God's kingdom is already here on earth and we are a part of that." He was planning and already executing plans in America and India. He stated that would like to work with [a large corporation in America] in developing a huge business, service, philanthropy project between that company, India and Texas, a huge philanthropy and charity starting in Texas and India, etc.

He also stated that he is "only focused on salvation all issues and helping people come to a restored relationship with God through Christ by faith and practice."

He also wanted to start a church. He wrote, that he this ministry "to give me a base understanding of how to set up a church properly so I don't have to deal with the state so that I don't have to worry about the legalities or limitations that have been laid in front of a 501(c)(3) church."

He had no understanding of the New Testament church. He stated that he wanted to set up an online organization that can be duplicated and added to. I explained "I do not help set up online organizations that can be duplicated or added to. A church under Christ is a local assembly of people ordered according to New Testament principles. That does not mean that a local church may not publish via internet its services, etc. as a ministry of the church." I explained the basics of what I believe the New Testament teaches about churches under Christ. I explained the New Testament order for ordination of pastors and planting of churches.

Many more details could be added. The point is that this ministry helps local autonomous churches, not anyone's conceptions of how to do God's work outside His only ordained institution for doing His work. This ministry helps only "local autonomous churches who wish to be ordered according to Christ's New Testament church doctrine."

2. January 10, 2020: Called the person who sent the following e-mail who got information on the ministry from Mark Taylor. I and answered the questions presented and more: "Hello Mr Finney, I left you a message a couple days ago regarding how to change from 501c3 with our ministry. We are not a church. I just read your reply to the missionary, July 1, 2019. From what I understand our ministry either has to remain 501c3 or once voluntarily revoked the moneys people contribute will be taxed. With that said, if we revoke the status, how are the contributions taxed? To us personally? Thank you for your time.

- 3. January 14, 2020: Reviewed completed <u>Questionnaire 1</u> with a Minnesota pastor with whom I had been working since December 10. E-mailed <u>Questionnaire 2</u> to him. He called me on January 18 or 19 and we discussed <u>Questionnaire 2</u> and some other matters.
- 4. January 20 2020: Had a lengthy phone conversation with a Massachusetts pastor who discovered the ministry website, has read *Separation of Church and State/God's Churches: Spiritual or Legal Entities* and is continuing to read my books. He wishes to organize the church according to Bible principles. We discussed many matters such as bank account, tax deductions for tithes offerings and gifts, etc. Sent initial letter; Policies, Procedures, and Guidelines; and Questionnaire 1.
- 5. January 20, 2020: Call from a young man in Temple, Texas who had questions regarding street preaching. I discussed the issues with him and sent him links to articles and a tract: Tract: Street Preaching in America: Is It Legal?; Northfield citizens seek to circumvent First Amendment (Op-ed published in the Northfield News, 041216); Street Preaching: A Misunderstood Blessing (Op-ed published in the Northfield News in repsonse to Article No. 68, 092414; Constitution Day events aim to remind Northfielders of their rights, spark discussions (by Kevin Krein kkrein@northfieldnews.com, 091214)(See footnote 1 below for a comment on this article); Protestors question Northfield's permit process (Grace Webb gwebb@northfieldnews.com, 080814)
