Boom! You absolutely nailed it! I said the same thing.. That's the only thing I would do too. You'll see why below.

I appreciate you taking the time to write me back. Please keep this as a prayer and keep contending for the faith that was once delivered to the saints. I appreciate you and the work you do and look up to you very highly. You are very loved in the Lord. I thank the Lord for the work you do and the convictions and stands you take. Keep on keeping on!!

Anyways I want to say also that I was telling my friend the following because this is my stand and convictions.

I was telling my friend I believe true Unaffiliated Historic Baptist Churches that are as well grounded and established in doctrine typically focus only on training someone designated to continue the pastorate of that church in the event of the loss of their pastor. It is exceptionally rare to find a church that is completely sound in doctrine who would consider a stranger to candidate. This in itself would indicate something is not sound.

Here are my words to a preacher I was speaking to the other day.

If it were me (because I have a conviction which I would never compromise one bit) I would never leave one church and pastor another church unless the church I would be leaving and would be going to was initially under the authority of and sent out of and sponsored and planted by the church I was leaving in done way. It must be a mother or sister church of my home church. Otherwise, I would always only leave to plant a new church under my home church .There must always be a connection for me to leave and go pastor another one. 100% of the time would go and plant another one under the authority of and sponsored by my home Church.

Here is where the problem arises and we continue to see it in our day non-stop.

This is why we see problems in our churches and why so many look outside of their ministry for candidates. Not training, discipling their own, and teaching doctrine. There is no understanding and no way of possibly seeing if these men are future pastors. Thus, they have to look outside of their church for men. I believe we should all be taught and trained thoroughly in all of the doctrines as if we are going to the field as a missionary, pastor, etc. even if we aren't and we are just layman. Each semester learn two different doctrines and be taught them diligently and strategically. This will also enable us all to be disciples and teach others and be one on one disciples.

I feel because this doesn't happen so many don't go out and preach and talk about Christ because they are afraid they will be asked something and not know how to respond or give an answer. Not being thoroughly trained, not just in the preaching and regular services, but also in an academic atmosphere. I don't believe being taught and trained as missionaries, pastors and etc. are just for those who are going to the field. It should be for every church member. Everyone the same way. Even if we are just layman in the church. They should be taught the same exact way and trained the same way. This is a problem in our churches and amongst our Baptist churches. And for those who do need a pastor why they have to look outside their four walls and not within. Sad!

True Unaffiliated local Historic Baptist churches always train their own men. Men not just to pastor or be an evangelist but also the layman and lay ladies are being trained the same exact way as a pastor or evangelist (not to become a pastor of course because that's against Scripture. Men are to have authority

and head over the ladies. We are all called to be ambassadors. Every person of the body of Christ (each local assembly) should whole heartedly be training as if they are going to the field even if they aren't.

We are not only to know our Bibles but also know how to give an answer, not just to our brothers and sisters but also to those who are lost. Every person should be taught and trained in all of the doctrines, not just the fundamentals and basic doctrines but all of the doctrines. Continuing to be throughly grounded through the preaching but just as much in an academic setting all under the authority of the local body. We see churches preaching only, but we don't see them training their body in an academic setting in all of the doctrines to ensure each and every person knows and is grounded in doctrine. We only see this from churches with the basic and fundamental doctrines, especially with new converts and basic Discipleship.

But after basic Discipleship (going over the basic doctrines in a thorough way), all that is expected of them is to be in all of the services. This is sad! Each and every member should continue to be taught more advanced doctrines in an academic way just like they were with basic Discipleship. Once they have completed the more advanced doctrines they should continue to go on and do the same with the next ones. Discipleship is ongoing! Each and every person should act as if they are going to the field and be grounded in all of the doctrines of the Bible even if they aren't going into fulltime ministry. Laymen and lay ladies should be doing and getting the same exact training as those who are going into fulltime ministry. Every church is to be their own training ground. Every church is to have their own Bible institute. Laymen and lay person's which include ladies too just as much as men train just as much in all of the doctrines as those who are going into fulltime ministry. Because this isn't the attitude and conviction of our churches today..

Guess what: fewer and fewer people are being called; fewer and fewer churches are being planted; and fewer and fewer disciples growing to become fulltime laymen evangelist even if not called into fulltime MINISTRY. No hunger and thirst for the word of God and work of God! And why are we seeing less people go out and become soul winners and disciples making disciples even if they're just laymen and lay ladies? Because they aren't being trained and growing in and getting grounded in all of the doctrines. Being in all of the services are important but so is being taught and trained and growing in and being grounded in all of the Doctrines.

Why isn't our desire to train God's people to become effective ministers of the Lord Jesus Christ by building their spiritual character, broadening their theological knowledge, sharpening their biblical skills, and helping them apply the Divine truths of Scripture?

Why aren't out churches making and preaching and encouraging all of its members to be trained under the authority of a local NT church? This is the Bible way!

But no, instead the greatest of these tragedies of NT Christianity today is that, far too often, when church members desire a greater detailed teaching of Scripture or when a young man believes that the Lord would have him preach God's Word, these individuals begin looking (many times at the prompting of their pastor/leaders in their assembly) outside of the Lord's churches for a "Bible College/Seminary" (where "serious" or "real" Bible teaching is accomplished). This is unfortunate because one must look outside of Scripture to find a basis for doing so. Bible colleges are not in the Bible neither are mission boards, mission agencies, clearinghouses or church planting ministries and etc. It's the Lord's Church only! The church is sufficient! Churches are to be their own training ground not just for full time men but also for laymen and lay ladies. Everybody should be growing in and thoroughly trained in all of the counsel and Doctrines of God. Yes there's preaching, but I'm talking about them being trained academically in all of the Word and doctrines of God. Whether or not the person is or isn't going into fulltime ministry, the sane attitude and focus should be to be throughly train all church members in all of the counsel and Doctrines of God.

I believe that the center of a believer's biblical learning is solely and exclusively to be in under and through the local, NT church (Acts 18:24-28; cf. I Cor.16:19) where he/she will be taught "all the counsel of God" which is why "the house of God, which is the church of the living God" is called the "pillar and ground of the truth" (I Tim. 3:15).

We need to believe strongly and have a conviction that II Tim. 2:2 gives the practical summation of Why our churches need to get this conviction and see the instruction of Paul, by way of the Holy Spirit, that "the things" which we have been taught biblically from God's Word should be committed to other "faithful men" so that they, in turn, can pass those "things" on just as they have received them! It needs to be our belief and conviction that every NT church has a vested interest in this very practical truth. Each church being its own training ground with the same focus towards the laymen and lay ladies as it should be with those who are going into fulltime ministry. We are all to be ambassadors and be able to help and train others and be able to also have an answer to others who ask us. And as a result it will enable us and give us a more passion and heart to witness to the loss. I believe because this isn't our focus and heart of churches today we are lacking tremendously and very far from Gods will.

Also, you have already listed the real estate in the Appendix. Has the title transferring the real estate already been executed (unlikely, since docs signed 040520? If not, the Appendix is defective, since the property is not yet being held in the name of the trust. A new title transferring the property to the trust must be executed in order for the property to be listed in the Appendix. Also, if this is not done, the property is being held by one type of trust, and is legally church property, as we discussed. That nullifies much of what you have done in executing the new trust docs. Yes, you now have a "trust" bank account, but you also have another trust holding the real estate. It is very important that this matter be taken care of asap.

Please let me know your intentions on how to get this straightened out. Give me a call and we will discuss it. If you get a VM, leave a message and I will return your call asap.

As to the SS-4, it looks great, except for, on the second line from the bottom, after your name, you need to put a comma and then type in "trustee."
